## **Northeast Points Drive traffic detours in March**

The SR 520 Eastside Transit and HOV Project will soon have major impacts on traffic along Northeast Points Drive between 92nd Avenue Northeast and Lake Washington Boulevard/Bellevue Way. For two weeks in March much of the traffic on Northeast Points Drive will be detoured to 92nd Avenue Northeast as Eastside Corridor Constructors (ECC) installs a large culvert, works on utilities, rebuilds part of the roadway, and constructs retaining walls.

While neighborhood traffic along Northeast Points Drive has been rerouted to 92nd Avenue Northeast before, the detour this time will also include all traffic for the Plaza Yarrow Bay office building at 10210 NE Points Drive. ECC crews will be installing another fish-passable culvert just east of the office building which will cut off access to and from Bellevue Way while construction is under way.

#### March 12-16 culvert construction on Northeast Points Drive

- Northeast Point Drive is closed west of the Plaza Yarrow Bay Complex and east of 10210 NE Points Drive. The closure begins around 2 a.m.
- Drivers should use 92nd Avenue Northeast to access Northeast Points Drive west of the closure area.

#### March 16-19 culvert construction on Bellevue Way Northeast

- Bellevue Way Northeast will be closed from 10 p.m. Friday night to 5 a.m. Monday morning south of the SR 520 bridge for installation of a fish-passable culvert.
- Drivers should use Northup Way to 108th Avenue Northeast to 112th Avenue Northeast to get back to Bellevue Way Northeast south of the closure area.

### March 19-26 roadway construction on Northeast Points Drive

- Northeast Point Drive is closed east of 101st Way Northeast and west of 10210 NE Points Drive.
- Drivers should use 92nd Avenue Northeast to access Northeast Points Drive west of the closure area.

### **Detour in place March 12-26**



Note: Only one location will be closed at a time. Pedestrian and bicycle access maintained at all times.






#### **April to October roadway construction**

- Northeast Point Drive is closed west of 100th Lane Northeast and east of 96th Avenue Northeast from April through October.
- Drivers should use Bellevue Way to access Northeast Points Drive east of 96th Avenue Northeast.

#### **Construction noise**

In addition to the traffic restrictions local residents should also expect the usual impacts of large-scale construction. Noise, dust and lights during work at night will be occasional inconveniences as the project goes forward.
